MAXIMUM SIZE: 24" x 36" (61cm x 91cm) – outside perimeter 120" (305cm) One oversized entry is allowed – maximum size 140" (356cm) outside perimeter

NINE by FIVE: Must be 9"x 5" (23cm x 13cm) excluding the frame, stretched canvas accepted

MINIATURE: Maximum size 4"x 4" (10cm x 10cm) – outside perimeter 16" (40cm) excluding the frame

FRAMING: Paintings must be dry and framed with a soft hanging cord firmly attached with staples at back of painting.

COMMISSION: 25% will be charged on all paintings sold.

INSURANCE: Is your responsibility. BAS will take care but will not be responsible for loss or damage to paintings.

PRIZES: The Exhibition Judge will select the Best in Show winner of the Canterbury-Bankstown Council prize of \$800 and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in all sections (the Best in Show winning painting cannot also win the section prize). Most section awards are 1st \$250, 2nd Highly Commended \$75, 3rd Commended certificate.

Other Prizes: BAS Patron's award and Viewer's Choice prizes will be selected from all entries including section winners.

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per single painting (Miniatures 2 for \$10, Nine by Fives 2 for \$15)
