

Bankstown Art Society Annual Art Exhibition 2019

Doors open 2pm Saturday 13th July followed by
Official Opening and Presentation of Awards at 2.30pm
Exhibition hours 10am to 3pm Monday 15th, Tuesday 16th, Wednesday 17th July

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

BAS MEMBERS must be financial by Wednesday 26th June

ENTRIES: A limit of 3 paintings per artist

MAXIMUM SIZE: Outside perimeter 120" (305cm) example 24" x 36" (61cm x 91cm)
One oversized entry is allowed – maximum size 140" (356cm) outside perimeter

SMALL PAINTINGS: Maximum size – outside perimeter 30" (76cm) excluding the frame
example 6" x 8" (15cm x 20cm) or 9" x 5" (23cm x 13cm)

FRAMING: Paintings must be dry and framed with a soft hanging cord firmly attached with staples at back of painting.
D-rings are acceptable but WE WILL NOT ACCEPT metal screw eyes, metal frames or metal projections.
Paintings on unframed stretched canvas accepted if the sides are painted and stapled at the back.

IDENTIFICATION: Fix a clearly printed label to the **top left hand back** of the painting with:
Artist Name, Phone number, Section, Title, Medium and Price

COMMISSION: 25% will be charged on all paintings sold.

INSURANCE: Is your responsibility. BAS will take care but will not be responsible for loss or damage to paintings.

PRIZES: The Exhibition Judge will select the Best in Show winner of the Canterbury-Bankstown Council prize of \$600 and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in all sections (the Best in Show winning painting cannot also win the section prize).
Section awards are 1st \$200, 2nd Highly Commended \$75, 3rd Commended \$25.

Other Prizes: BAS Patron's award and Viewer's Choice prizes will be selected from all entries including section winners.

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per single painting

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRY FORMS: WEDNESDAY 26TH JUNE

Hand deliver entry form and fee to the BAS Office during class times or on any Wednesday 10am to 2pm
or post entry form and fee – postal address as above **LATE ENTRIES NOT ACCEPTED**

DELIVER PAINTINGS: To BAS Studio/Gallery on Monday 8th July 10am to 1pm
or contact Noela Fisher 9771 5708 to make alternative arrangements

COLLECT PAINTINGS: Thursday 18th July 10am to 12noon (alternative arrangements can be made)

ENTRIES: must have been completed within the **past 24 months**, must be your own original work and not previously entered in a BAS Annual Exhibition. Copies from magazines, books, or other artists not accepted.

All entries must be for sale except for a Portrait

SECTIONS

Section 1 Oil or Acrylic painted as oil

Section 2 Water Medium, watercolour paints, gouache, thin washes of acrylic paints

Section 3 Contemporary/Modern

Section 4 Traditional Australian Landscape

Section 5 Works on Paper, mixed media, collage, pen & ink, pastel etc. – NOT on canvas

Section 6 Small Paintings
